COOKERY REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors must ensure that their produce is entered in the correct class as transfers are not permitted.
2. Each entry must be the work of the individual exhibitor.
3. Cookery items which have been accepted for exhibition at a previous Stroud Show will not be eligible.
4. All Cookery items must have been made within 12 months prior to the first day of the current Stroud Show.
5. Cookery items can only be entered once per category.
6. Entries must not have names identifying the exhibitor.
7. Cookery items must remain on display until 2pm on the Sunday of the show.
8. Judges decision is final.
9. Entries close the Thursday before the show at 10am.
10. All entries must be delivered to the "Secretaries Office" before 11am, the Thursday before the show, during the Secretaries Office hours. Secretaries Office hours are displayed on the Stroud Show website.
11. Cookery items must be delivered with entry tags.
12. The "Allen Pavilion" will close at 2pm on the Sunday of the show to begin the removal of cookery for collection.
13. Cookery items can be collected between 3pm and 4pm on the Sunday of the show from the "Allen Pavilion".
14. Cookery items may be photographed for promotional purposes in relation to the Stroud Show.
