PRODUCE REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors must ensure that their home brew is entered in the correct class as transfers are not permitted.
2. Each entry must be the work of the individual exhibitor.
3. Home brew which has been accepted for exhibition at a previous Stroud Show will not be eligible.
4. All exhibits must have been brewed within 12 months prior to the first day of the current Stroud Show.
5. All exhibitors must be over the age of 18 years.
6. Entries must not have names identifying the exhibitor.
7. Each entry in beer classes to consist of one 750mL bottle (long neck preferred) or two 375mL bottles.
8. Exhibits must remain on display until 3pm on the Sunday of the show.
9. Judging to be on a points system awarded for; colour, clarity, head holding and flavour, aroma and body.
10. Judges decision is final.
11. Entries close the Thursday before the show at 10am.
12. All entries must be delivered to the "Secretaries Office" before 11am, the Thursday before the show, during the Secretaries Office hours. Secretaries Office hours are displayed on the Stroud Show website.
13. Exhibits must be delivered with entry tags.
14. The "Allen Pavilion" will close at 2pm on the show Sunday to begin the removal of exhibits for collection.
15. Exhibits can be collected between 3pm and 4pm on the Sunday of the show from the "Allen Pavilion".

16. Home brew may be photographed for promotional purposes in relation to the Stroud Show.
