PRODUCE REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors must ensure that their needlework and craft is entered in the correct class as transfers are not permitted.
2. Each entry must be the work of the individual exhibitor.
3. Needlework and craft which have been accepted for exhibition at a previous Stroud Show will not be eligible.
4. All needlework and craft must have been created within 2 years prior to the first day of the current Stroud Show.
5. Needlework and craft can only be entered once per category.
6. Entries must not have names identifying the exhibitor.
7. Needlework and Craft must remain on display until 2pm on the Sunday of the show.
8. Judges decision is final.
9. Entries close the Thursday before the show at 10am.
10. All entries must be delivered to the "Secretaries Office" before 11am, the Thursday before the show, during the Secretaries Office hours. Secretaries Office hours are displayed on the Stroud Show website.
11. Needlework and Craft must be delivered with entry tags.
12. The "Allen Pavilion" will close at 2pm on the Sunday of the show to begin the removal of exhibits for collection.
13. Needlework and Craft can be collected between 3pm and 4pm on the Sunday of the show from the "Allen Pavilion".
14. Needlework and Craft may be photographed for promotional purposes in relation to the Stroud Show.

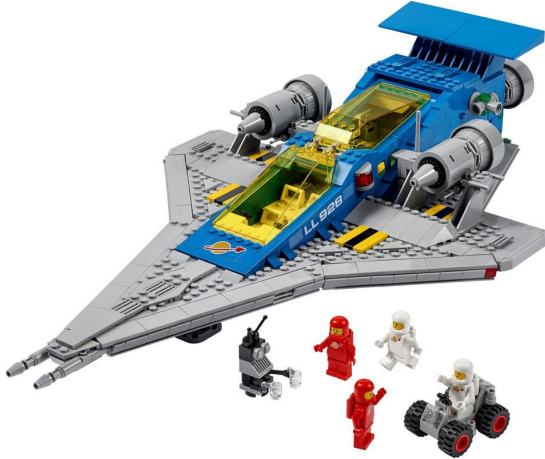
