PHOTOGRAPHY REGULATIONS

- 1. Exhibitors must ensure that their photograph is entered in the correct class as transfers are not permitted.
- 2. Each entry must be the work of the individual exhibitor.
- 3. Photographs which have been accepted for exhibition at a previous Stroud Show will not be eligible.
- 4. All photographs must have been taken within 12 months prior to the first day of the current Stroud Show.
- 5. Photographs can only be entered in one class.
- 6. Photographs must be mounted ON or BEHIND light-medium weight white/cream cardboard with a maximum overall size, including photograph and cardboard of 8"x10" (20cmx25cm). No Frames, photographs presented in frames or over size specifications will not be judged.
- 7. Exhibitors are limited to three photographs in each Class.
- 8. Entries must not have names identifying the exhibitor.
- 9. Photographs must remain on display until 2pm on the Sunday of the show.
- 10. Judges decision is final.
- 11. Entries close the Thursday before the show at 10am.
- 12. All entries must be delivered to the "Secretaries Office" before 11am, the Thursday before the show, during the Secretaries Office hours. Secretaries Office hours are displayed on the Stroud Show website.
- 13. Entries must be delivered with entry tags.
- 14. The "Allen Pavilion" will close at 2pm on the Sunday of the show to begin the removal of photographs for collection.
- 15. Photographs can be collected between 3pm and 4pm on the Sunday of the show from the "Allen Pavilion".
- 16. Every care will be taken of exhibits. The Stroud Show Pty Ltd will not be responsible for any loss or damages.
- 17. Photographs may be photographed for promotional purposes in relation to the Stroud Show.
