PRESERVES REGULATIONS

- 1. Exhibitors must ensure that their preserve is entered in the correct class as transfers are not permitted.
- 2. Each entry must be homemade and the work of the individual exhibitor.
- 3. Preserves which have been accepted for exhibition at a previous Stroud Show will not be eligible.
- 4. All preserves must have been made within 12 months prior to the first day of the current Stroud Show.
- 5. Preserves can only be entered once per category.
- 6. Entries must not have names identifying the exhibitor.
- 7. Lids on bottles must be removable and not sealed with wax. Lids to be plain.
- 8. Entries must be cleanly presented in clean jars of approximately 250-375mL and clearly labelled with the contents only. E.g "Tomato Relish". No advertising or other labels to be left on jars.
- 9. Pantry Collection it is essential to have a variety.
- 10. Jams are best when fresh. Pickles and chutney are best after at least a month.
- 11. Please loosen lids for judging. Pantry and Preserves are exempt.
- 12. Preserves must remain on display until 2pm on the Sunday of the show.
- 13. Judges decision is final.
- 14. Entries close the Thursday before the show at 10am.
- 15. All entries must be delivered to the "Secretaries Office" before 11am, the Thursday before the show, during the Secretaries Office hours. Secretaries Office hours are displayed on the Stroud Show website.
- 16. Entries must be attached with entry tags.
- 17. The "Allen Pavilion" will close at 2pm on the Sunday of the show to begin the removal of preserves for collection.
- 18. Entries can be collected between 3pm and 4pm on the Sunday of the show from the "Allen Pavilion".
- 19. Preserves may be photographed for promotional purposes in relation to the Stroud Show.
