## PRODUCE REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors must ensure that their produce is entered in the correct class as transfers are not permitted.
2. Each entry must be the work of the individual exhibitor.
3. Produce which has been accepted for exhibition at a previous Stroud Show will not be eligible.
4. All produce must have been grown within 12 months prior to the first day of the current Stroud Show.
5. Produce can only be entered once per category.
6. Entries must not have names identifying the exhibitor.
7. Produce must remain on display until 2 pm on the Sunday of the show.
8. Judges decision is final.
9. Entries close the Thursday before the show at 10am.
10. All entries must be delivered to the "Secretaries Office" before 11 am , the Thursday before the show, during the Secretaries Office hours. Secretaries Office hours are displayed on the Stroud Show website.
11. Entries in Class 5007 must supply straps, bags, pallet or similar to lift exhibit with tractor forks.
12. Produce must be delivered with entry tags.
13. The "Produce Pavilion" will close at 2 pm on the Sunday of the show to begin the removal of produce for collection.
14. Produce can be collected between 3pm and 4pm on the Sunday of the show from the "Produce Pavilion".
15. Produce may be photographed for promotional purposes in relation to the Stroud Show.
