## WOODCRAFT REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors must ensure that their entries are entered in the correct Class as transfers are not permitted.
2. Each Exhibit must be the work of the individual Exhibitor.
3. Works which have been accepted for exhibition at a previous Stroud Show will not be eligible.
4. All Exhibits must have been completed within 18 months prior to the first day of the current Stroud Show.
5. Soiled and damaged work will not be accepted.
6. Entry identification tag must be securely attached and visible.
7. Exhibits must remain on display until 2pm on the Sunday of the show. This includes any Exhibits that have been purchased.
8. Judges decisions are final. Feedback can be provided to Exhibitors if the judge makes comment.
9. Entries close the Thursday before the show at 10am.
10. All entries must be delivered to the "Secretaries Office" before 11am, the Thursday before the show, during the Secretaries Office hours. Secretaries Office hours are displayed on the Stroud Show website.
11. "The Pavilion" will close at 2pm on the Sunday of the show to begin the removal of Exhibits for collection. Exhibits can be collect between 3pm and 4pm on the show Sunday.
12. Exhibitors wishing to sell their Exhibit must attach a price tag next to the entry identification tag stating the amount the Exhibit is to be sold for. The Stroud Show Incorporated retains 10% commission of sold Exhibits.
13. Exhibits may be photographed for promotional purposes in relation to the Stroud Show.



## **SECTION 14**

### **WOODCRAFT**

THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS APPLY TO CLASSES 14001-14004.

- Maximum height 120cm, base no greater than 80cm x 80cm.
- Must be handled by one person.
- Maximum weight must not exceed 15kg.

#### **Class 14001 - UPCYCLED FURNITURE**

- Decorated in any style, or combination of styles, including but not limited to, decorative paint finishes (e.g. stencilling, distressing), applied paper, fabric or trimming.
- May be new or second-hand, but not in its original condition.



#### **Class 14002 - WOODCARVING**

- All disciplines.
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber.

#### **Class 14003 - SMALL FURNITURE ITEM**

- All disciplines.
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber.

#### **Class 14004 - RECLAIMED TIMBER ITEM**

- All disciplines.
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber.

#### **Class 14005 - BOWLS**

- Any turned item which can resemble a bowl.
- Item must not have a cover or lid.
- Turned from one piece of timber, either solid or laminated but not segmented. Item can be embellished in anyway, but the Judge must be satisfied that the piece shows 80% turning.

#### **Class 14006 - CHOPPING, CHEESE, CHARCUTERIE OR PIZZA BOARD**

- All disciplines.
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber.

#### **Class 14007 - DRINK COASTER SET**

- All disciplines.
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber.
- Drink coaster set must contain at least four coasters.

#### **Class 14008 - DRINK CADDY**

- All disciplines.
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber.
- Caddy must be able to hold six bottles or cans of a beverage.
- Caddy must be displayed with empty beverage bottles or cans.
- Caddy may be painted or decorated.

#### **Class 14009 - SMALL GIFT**

- All disciplines.
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber.

#### **Class 14010 - CHILDREN'S TOY, PUZZLE OR GAME**

- All disciplines.
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber.
- Toy, puzzle or game may be painted or decorated.
