ENTRY FEES: All Classes - \$2 (Members=Adults) (Non-members=U18)

NUMBERS OF ENTRIES: Two entries per class maximum

DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS: Thursday 24th April to "The Pavilion" between 5pm & 6pm

COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS: Sunday 27th April from "The Pavilion" after 3pm.

DISPLAY LOCATION: "The Pavilion" Stroud Showground, Stroud

WOODCRAFT REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors must ensure that their entries are entered into the correct Class as transfers are not permitted.
2. Exhibitors competing in Class 1-10 will be allowed only two exhibits in each Class.
3. Each Exhibit must be the work of the individual Exhibitor
4. Works which have been accepted for exhibition at a previous Stroud Show will not be eligible.
5. All exhibits must have been completed within 18 months prior to the first day of the Stroud Show.
6. Soiled and damaged work will not be accepted.
7. Entry identification tag must be securely attached and visible.
8. Exhibits must remain on display until 2pm on the Sunday of the show. This includes any Exhibits that have been purchased.
9. Judges decisions are final. Feedback can be provided to Exhibitors if the judge makes comment.
10. Entries close Thursday 4th April at 10am. All exhibits must be delivered to 'The Pavilion' between 5pm and 6pm 4th April. Exhibits may be left prior to that time, at the Secretaries Office, at the discretion of the Show Secretary.
11. 'The Pavilion' will close at 2pm Sunday 7th April to begin removal of Exhibits for collection.

12. Exhibitors wishing to sell their Exhibit must attach a price tag next to the entry identification tag stating the sale price on the Exhibit. The Stroud Show Association Inc retains 10% commission on all Exhibits that are sold at the Show.
13. Exhibits may be photographed for promotional purposes in relation to the Stroud Show.

THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS APPLY TO CLASSES 1-4

- Maximum height 120cm, base no greater than 80cm x 80cm
- Must be able to be handled by one person
- Maximum weight must not exceed 15kg

Class 14001 Upcycled Furniture

- Decorated in any style, or combination of styles, including but not limited to, decorative paint finishes (eg stenciling, distressing), applied paper, fabric or trimming
- May be new or second-hand, but not in its original condition

Class 14004 Reclaimed Timber Item

Class 14005 Bowls

- Any turned item which can resemble a bowl.
- Item must not have a cover or lid
- Turned from one piece of timber, either solid or laminated but not segmented. Item can be embellished in anyway, but the Judge must be satisfied that the piece shows 80% turning.

Class 14006 Chopping board-Cheese, Charcuterie or Pizza

- All disciplines
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber

Class 14007 Drink Coaster Set

- All disciplines
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber
- Drink coaster set must contain at least four coasters

Class 14008 Drink Caddy

- All disciplines
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber

- Caddy must be able to hold six bottles or cans of a beverage
- Caddy must be displayed with empty beverage bottles or can
- Caddy may be painted or decorated

Class 14009 Small Gift

- All disciplines
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber

Class 14010 Childrens Toy, Puzzle or Game

- All disciplines
- The Judge must be satisfied that the piece is 80% timber
- Toy, puzzle or game may be painted or decorated
